Section 210.1080 RSMo specifies criminal background checks for child care staff members. The requirements for religious organizations operating a child care facility are as follows:  Facilities operated by a religious organization that receive federal funds for providing care for children must have qualifying background screening results for child care staff members pursuant to 210.1080.1(1) RSMo.  Facilities operated by a religious organization and that do not receive federal funds for providing care for children are not required to have qualifying background screening results for all child care staff members pursuant to 210.1080.9 RSMo.  Child care staff members pursuant to 210.1080.9 RSMo.  Child care staff members of facilities operated by a religious organization that receive federal funds for providing care for children, with disqualifying background screening results are prohibited from being on the premises during child care hours.  Facilities operated by a religious organization that receive federal funds for providing care for children, must request criminal background checks for child care staff members every 5 years, as defined in 210.1080.1(1) RSMo.  BACKGROUND CHECKS HAVE BEEN CONDUCTED AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 210.1080 RSMO.  FACILITY DISCIPLINE AND EDUCATIONAL PHILOSOPHY/POLICIES  THE DISCIPLINARY PHILOSOPHY AND POLICIES OF THIS FACILITY ARE:  Our staff operates under the premises that discipline means "to teach." Children will be given choices in order to have ownership in the learning that comes through discipline. Staff members will model use of positive language and give specific alternatives instead of "don't and "no" as much as possible. All discipline will address behavior and the consequences of that behavior. Therefore, each situation will be individually assessed by a staff member. Discipline is based on rules we all need to learn and accept to function with others. Basic rules of kindness, courtesy, and safety will be enforced. Children in conflict will work with a staff member to solve
